 - As we target students from less advantaged areas of the East Bay, we are especially interested in candidates who themselves grew up in these areas or who overcame similar obstacles to succeed in high school and college

- Managers
 - All our managers are educators and also teach for Aspire (see above)
 - Managers take on a variety of tasks, including:
 - interacting with clients (parents and school administrators)
 - coordinating with other providers and collaborators
 - researching and establishing new services
 - hiring and training other educators
 - contributing to strategic planning
 - Managers are given a guaranteed salary while maintaining a great deal of flexibility over scheduling and tasking
 - Aspire is an organization that values involvement: managers especially have the opportunity to shape the future of a new and quickly growing organization, and take on roles with increasing responsibilities
